The Verbano Yacht Club one of the oldest Yacht Clubs in Italy (since 1895) situated in the quaint lake-side town of Stresa, facing the famous Borromee islands, will be hosting as usual a wonderful weekend.

As far back as the early 1900s, motorboat races and some of the most important sailboat regattas of Lake Maggiore, were organized at the Verbano Yacht Club.

During the three days of the meeting we will visit the far North end of the lake down to Locarno, crossing over to the Southern part of the Ticino river, navigating along the “via dei marmi” (the marble route) currently open for navigation, which crosses the Miorina Lock up to Porto Torre. The “via dei marmi” was used as far back as the year 300 to transport the massive blocks of marble used in the construction of the Duomo of Milan.
